DR WILLY DAYAN
DDS, DIP. ORTHO

Dr Dayan received his DDS in 1986 and his diploma in Orthodontics in 1991 both from the University of Toronto.

In addition to his private practice in orthodontics, Dr Dayan is also a clinical instructor of Orthodontics. His teaching expertise lies in areas of: Invisalign Aligner Biomechanics, Esthetic Adult Orthodontic Techniques, and Rehabilitative Orthodontics in preparation for Cosmetic Reconstructive Dentistry, Patient Interviews and Treatment Presentation Skills. He has been a guest lecturer at multiple conventions and meetings worldwide and continues to guest lecture at the Department of Orthodontics in Universities worldwide.

imaging in orthodontics, and analysis of dento-alveolar structures and their interaction with external mechanical stimuli studied using in-vitro, in-vivo, and in-silico models. At present, he is actively involved in projects dealing with clinical outcome analysis in 3D. He has authored over 100 publications in peer-reviewed international journals and book chapters.

Paolo M. Cattaneo received his MSc. in Bio-Mechanical Engineering at Polytechnic of Milan, Italy, and his PhD. in Dentistry from Aarhus University, Denmark. He successfully completed The Leadership Development Programme for Head of Departments at the Copenhagen Business School – Executive, Copenhagen, Denmark.

PROFESSOR MARIE CORNELIS

Marie A Cornelis received both her dental degree (1999) and her postgraduate specialist degree in orthodontics (2003) from the University of Louvain, in Brussels. In 2007, she was a Visiting Research scholar at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She defended her PhD about miniplates as temporary skeletal anchorage in Brussels in 2008. In 2010, she finished a 2-year degree in

lingual orthodontics at the Université Descartes (Paris). Between 2009 and 2014, she was Assistant Professor at the Department of Orthodontics of the University of Geneva. From 2014 to 2020, she was Associate Professor and Postgraduate Program Director of the Section of Orthodontics, Department of Dentistry, Aarhus University, and in 2015 she became Head of Section. At the same time, she maintained an active orthodontic practice in an interdisciplinary office in Geneva a few days per month. Marie was awarded the WJB Houston Oral Research Award of the European Orthodontic Society in 2008 and the Dewel award as a (co)author of the best clinical paper in the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics in 2012 and in 2023. She is an Active Member of the Angle Society of Europe and a full member of the European Board of Orthodontists. In 2021, Marie became Professor and Head of Orthodontics at the Melbourne Dental School. Her research interests are focused on clinical orthodontics, mainly skeletal anchorage, digital workflows and stability/retention.



DR NOUR ELDIN TARRAF

BDS(Hons), MDSc(Hons), PhD, MOrth RCSEd, MRACDS (Ortho)

Nour finished his BDS at Cairo University with Honors in 2001 followed by an orthodontic residency at Cairo University. He then moved to Sydney where he completed his Masters degree in Orthodontics at the University of Sydney in 2008 with Honors. He works in private practice in Chatswood, Sydney and is involved in research and teaching at the University of Sydney. Nour has a special interest in invisible orthodontic techniques such as lingual orthodontics and Invisalign. He is the past president of the Australasian Society Of Lingual Orthodontics. He is also the first and only Australian to become a Titular member of the European Society of Lingual Orthodontics and an Active member of the World Society of Lingual Orthodontics.

Among his special interests are the use of digital technology in orthodontics, early orthodontics and growth modification treatment and he recently completed a PhD on the application of skeletal anchorage in maxillary growth modification for growing children. He has lectured nationally and internationally and has number of scientific publications.

In his free time Nour likes to spend time with his daughters Hana and Maryam. He loves sport and after years of doing triathlon has taken up the new challenge of Nordic biathlon in the winter.

DR MARK MOORE

Plastic & Craniofacial Surgeon – Head of Cleft and Craniofacial SA

Dr Mark Moore arrived in Adelaide, South Australia in January 1987 to start his role as a Craniofacial Fellow, where he trained with Dr David David and Dr Jim Trott in the previously named South Australian Craniofacial Unit (SACFU). Thirty years later, Mark is still in Adelaide and is now the Head of the Cleft and Craniofacial SA (C&CSA) (formally the Australian Craniofacial Unit).

Mark passed his final plastic surgical examination in late 1986, before venturing to Adelaide where his final year of training was completed as a Craniofacial Fellow in 1987. He then spent his second year as a Senior Registrar in Plastic Surgery at the Royal Adelaide Hospital (RAH), before commencing as a Consultant Plastic Surgeon at the Royal Adelaide Hospital (RAH), Women's and Children's Hospital (WCH), Adelaide and Lyell McEwin Health Service the following year.

In 1988, Mark was awarded his FRACS qualification (Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery) and was appointed as a Consultant CF Surgeon at SACFU in 1990. Mark continued as a Senior Visiting Craniofacial Surgeon in the renamed Cleft and Craniofacial SA (C&CSA) until 2001. Mark was then appointed Head of Paediatric Plastic Surgery at Women's and Children's Hospital (WCH) until 2008, when he returned to the Cleft and Craniofacial SA (C&CSA) and was appointed Head of Unit in 2017.

Mark is a founding member of the Asia-Pacific Craniofacial Association and the Australia and New Zealand Society of Craniofacial Surgery and is full active member of the International Society of Craniofacial Surgery since 1999.



DR VICKI VLASKALIC

BDS, DDS; MDS.

Dr Vlaskalic attended the University of Melbourne where she received both her Bachelor of Dental Science and Master of Dental Science degrees. In 1994, she was awarded an ASOFRE research scholarship and spent 2 years at UCLA, with a further 6 years as Assistant Professor and Director of Predoctoral Orthodontics at the University of the Pacific, San Francisco. In 1997, Dr Vlaskalic became co-investigator in the feasibility of the Invisalign appliance, and published the original article in 2000. During her 6 years at Pacific, Dr Vlaskalic obtained her California Dental License (DDS), was instrumental in the introduction of the system throughout the USA, APAC and the Middle East and received various teaching and research awards, including 3 from the American Association of Orthodontists Foundation. Dr Vlaskalic has presented abstracts and papers at prestigious meetings such as the IADR, AAO, WFO and is published in refereed journals. Since returning to Melbourne, she works in orthodontic specialty practice, is a clinical instructor at the University of Melbourne and continues lecturing and consulting world-wide.

DR TONY WEIR

Married to Sharon, with 3 grown-up children. Sharon and I have run more than 30 ultramarathons together and enjoy high-altitude trekking in Nepal, Africa, and South America. I have a BDS (Hons) Queensland 1983 and MDS Ortho Adelaide 1991.

I have been researching aligners via university appointments for the past 5 years. I have collected a large database of cases (15,000 plus) from 15 experienced orthodontists in Australia, New Zealand and the United States to enable independent research into the efficacy of aligners, which is my primary research interest. I was 2021 Milton Sims Visiting Professor, University of Adelaide and in 2022 I was awarded the P Raymond Begg Research Award, Australian Society of Orthodontists.

Dr Andrew Cheng is a fully qualified Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon. He obtained his dental and medical degrees from the University of Adelaide. He has been working in private practice since 2005 and currently is the principle owner of his own private practice in Adelaide.

He has obtained extensive experience in oral surgery, oral pathology and dental implant surgery. In 2014, he completed the comprehensive Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery training program from the Royal college of Dental Surgeons.

During his training, he has worked in the United Kingdom, Taiwan, Shanghai, and Wuhan. In 2010, he completed a clinical fellowship in the Ninth people's hospital where he gained further experience in complex orthognathic surgery, computer assisted maxillofacial surgery, Endoscopic technique in temporomandibular joint and salivary gland pathology, Navigational Cranial-maxillofacial surgery, Facial trauma, Head and Neck oncology and Micro-reconstructive surgery. He has worked with and learned from leading surgeons in Oral and Maxillofacial and Plastic Reconstructive Surgery around the world.

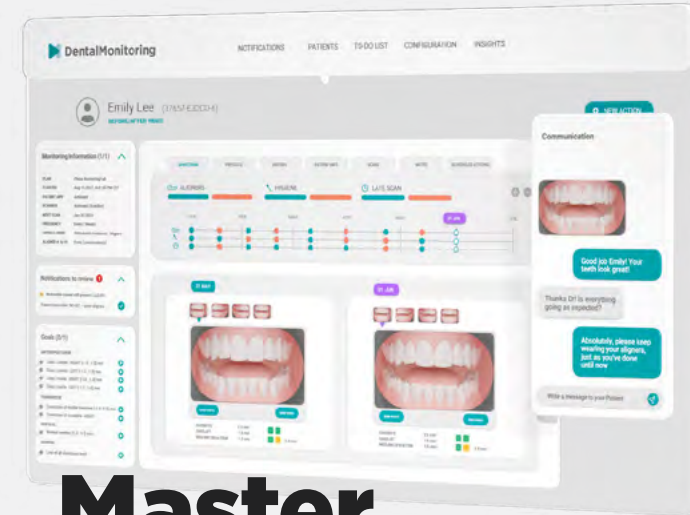
DR HARRY PERKINS

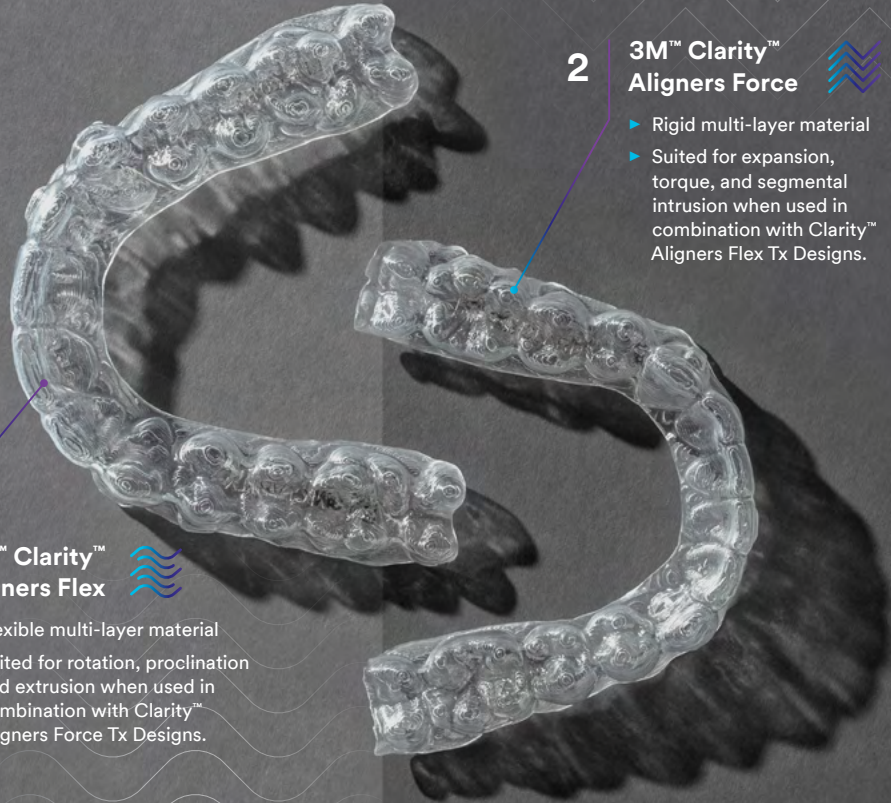

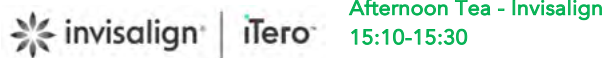

Severe malocclusions with skeletal element impose a challenge to the current orthodontic specialty. Simple appliances such as brackets with archwires may not address complicated skeletal defects due to their inadequate impact on bone structures. Orthopedic approaches have proven to be effective solutions to the skeletal anomalies. The specially designed and customized manufactured clear orthopedic appliances, including segittally guided twin block (S8-SGTB), modified Herbst (S8-SGHB) and a variety of tailored clear appliances, are used to modify the growth patterns of the orofacial bone structures and therefore to correct jaw discrepancies efficiently and effectively. Radiographic evidence in condylar new bone formation generated by mandibular advancement inspires an encouraging impetus to orthopedic modalities. S8-SGTB and S8-SGHB also demonstrate promising efficacy in treating malocclusions concurring with TMD, due to their effects in provoking adaptive remodeling of TMJ condyles in response to mandibular repositioning. This lecture will present an overview on the latest advances in clinical orthodontics evidenced by a wealth of literature review and beautifully finished cases.

Based on the prior lecture, this forum gives the in-depth details and specifics on clinical implementation of S8, including the new diagnostic classification system and its relevance to the S8 indications, working bite wax recording and registration, phasic goal determining and designing, the teeth movement and curve of Spee flattening incorporated into phase one, the transition from phase one to phase two, inspection and amendment of simulated animations, radiographic film taking and evidence examination of TMJ remodeling, criteria for case completion, and patient recall for long term follow up. Adequate proportion of time is given to an instructive demonstration and hands-on practice on working bite registration, including the three-dimensional requirement for mandibular repositioning in different scenarios, the placement of wax and precise mandibular relocation.

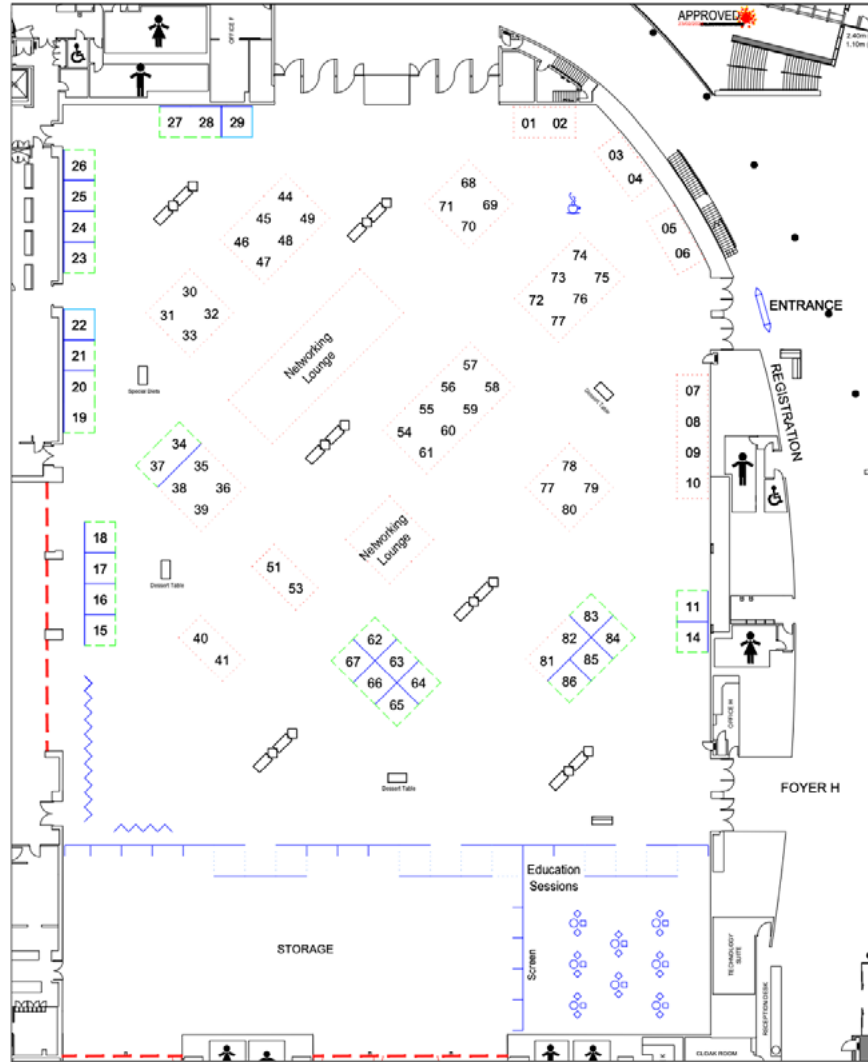
